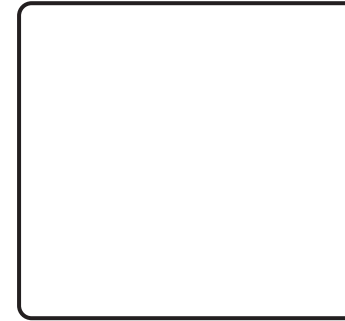
VISION

A GUIDELINE FOR DISCIPLINE AND ORDER

1. The school authorities rely upon the full co-operation of the parents/Gurdians in all matters concerning the education of their child.
2. Parents are expected to go through the calender thoroughly and get themselves acquainted with the rules and regulations of the school and sign and submit the Declaration form.
3. Remarks made in the diary by the H.M. or the Teacher Should be seen and signed by the Parents / Guardian.
4. Every day's home - work should be seen & signed by the parents or guardian.
5. "NO PARENT IS PERMITTED TO MEET THE TEACHER DURING CLASS HOURS" Without Permission.
6. IF ANY COMPLAINT IS TO BE MADE PLEASE MEET THE H.M. Between 3-15 to 4.30 P.M.
7. A Student who disturbs the class in any manner or does not maintain discipline will be recorded in the school black mark register.
8. Students strictly advised to speak in English in School hours.
9. Students are requested to help in keeping the class room and premises tidy.
11. Students are expected to take care of their books and personal belongings. It is advisable not to bring valuable articles to school. The Teachers are not responsible for goods lost.
12. Any Students desiring to be exempted from P.T. or Games must produce a doctor's certificate to the effect that she/he is physically unfit to take part.

13. Any damage done to the class - room or to the school property has to be made good by the student.
14. The H.M. shall place herself in communication when necessary with parents or guardian of students who are very backward in their studies and do not show any improvement or whose attendance is very irregular or conduct unsatisfactory.
15. Students are expected to wrap all their books with plastic paper and use lables to write the name. Cover must be changed as they get dirty and worn out.
16. Students must have their lunch outside the class room and students are not allowed to go home at lunch time.
17. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the school for students. Students found using/carrying mobile phones will be accountable for the consequences & the phone will be confiscated.
18. Students are prohibited from bringing Cameras, CDS, DVD, Slam books, picture magazine, comics, Video games, Radio or any kind of electronic gadgets.
19. Change of clothes or shoes without specific permission from the principal is prohibited.
20. School diary should be brought to school everyday, "record of late entry" to school will be recorded in diary.
21. Although parents are responsible for the behaviour of their children outside school, the school will take necessary action when such behaviour is reported to be immoral or violent.
22. Cheating, helping other students or any other malpractice in an examination disqualifies the student from the whole examination.

TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

During the academic year, there will be 4 Formative assessment (FA) test and 2 Summative assessment (SA) exams will be held during the month of September and March.

Promotion Rules

1. Performance of your child in curricular and co-curricular activities in each of the examination will be assessed through gradation. FA will not be considered for promotion.
2. Result will be decided on the basis of average grades secured in Examinations.
3. A student must secure a minimum of two "C+" grades in curricular subjects and two "B" grades in co-curricular subjects in the examinations.

Attendance :

1. A pupil will be eligible to appear in the examination if he/she has a minimum of 75% attendance.
2. Leave to student for absence is granted only on an application addressed to the H.M. through the class Teacher submitted in time, duly attested by the Parents.
3. The period of leave with reasons should also be recorded in the student's Calender by the Parent with signature.
4. In case of illness, a Medical Certificate must be attached with the application. Long absence except in case of illness should be discouraged.
5. The name of the student will be struck off the attendance rolls of the school if he/she is absent for more than 1 week continuously without sanction of leave.

Punctuality and Regularity :

1. Students must develop the habits of punctuality and regularity.
2. Students should reach the School at least by 9.10 a.m.
3. Students should submit their assignment and projects to the teacher regularly and in time.
4. Students with 100% attendance will be appreciated.

Students bicycle or vehicle parked outside school compound will not be the responsibility of the school management.

- ☞ Wearing fancy watches & accessories.
- ☞ Applying nail polish, lip glass or lipstick with glitter or colour mehandi etc.

A Note to parents

- ☞ The school expects full co-operation of the parents and guardians in all matters concerning the education of the child.
- ☞ Parents are to read the school diary every evening and see to it that the lessons and homework assigned for the next day is done.
- ☞ It is important that you make note of the remarks made in the diary by the principal or the teacher and sign. Parents must attend all the meeting conducted at school.
- ☞ Please encourage the child to dress neatly to school, keep their personal belongings carefully, polish shoes, maintain personal hygiene and take pride in their work.
- ☞ Please ensure that you follow the school calendar as well and avoid taking the child out for social functions and other gatherings during school days
- ☞ Any form of criticism of the teacher or the school in front of the students is to be strictly avoided. If done, the student loses respect for his/her teacher and the school and fails to learn from the teacher. If there is a genuine problem, it is advisable to contact the school principal.
- ☞ Parents have to approach the principal in case of any confusion regarding the academic and not to create any disturbance amongst themselves.
